Working Group - Visitor Information Centre

Since the Tourism Forum Event back in April last year, we have been busy exploring options for retaining some form of visitor information. Our sub-group have met online and in person and have recently visited the iCentre to see the space. The options being considered include:

- Taking over the rental agreement from VisitScotland (currently in place until 2028)
- Securing a new rental agreement with Orkney Islands Council
- Purchasing the entire building through a 'community buy-out', with assistance from Scottish Land Fund or Orkney Towns Board

Along with the provision of visitor information, the upper floor (above the iCentre) could be utilised better and could be transformed into a dual-purpose space and used as a town centre venue for live music, performance and storytelling as well as space for exhibitions of local art and demonstrations of local crafts.

To help progress with our investigations, we will shortly be sending out emails/letters to Orkney businesses and organisations to ask for support. We can only progress further if there is desire by the community and local operators to retain this facility and to evolve and adapt it for better use.
